**Notice – Minimum amount payable for ceasing deliveries under clause 17.1(b)(1) of the Victorian LPG Retail Code**

The Victorian LPG Retail Code (**Code**) is reviewed by the Code Governance Body (**CGB**) on an ongoing basis. The CGB is responsible for updating the Code, receiving voluntary undertakings from LPG retailers, managing promotion of the Code, and other functions conferred on it under the Code.

Under the Code, an LPG retailer may, subject to prescribed conditions, cease the delivery of LPG to an Account Customer due to non-payment. Clause 17.1(b)(1) of the Code prohibits an LPG retailer from refusing to deliver LPG to an Account Customer if the amount payable by the customer is less than **seventy dollars**, or any variation to this amount as nominated by the CGB. This threshold has not been amended since the inception of the Code.

The CGB has recently undertaken a review to ensure that this amount continues to align with the current domestic LPG market in Victoria. As a result of this review and in accordance with the referenced clause, the CGB has agreed to nominate a new amount.

The new amount payable under clause 17.1(b)(1) of the Code is **one hundred dollars**. This change is effective from 1 October 2017 and continues until further notice.
