Traffic surveys for the Gippsland offshore wind transmission 2 GW project

VicGrid is developing a new shared transmission line to connect offshore wind energy generated off the coast of Gippsland to the electricity grid.

As part of our early planning work, we're carrying out technical studies to help identify and manage any potential impacts.

What we're doing and when

Throughout September, we'll be doing traffic surveys in and around the project area. These surveys will involve:

- Watching and recording how much traffic is on public roads
- Using traffic tube counters to measure vehicle numbers.

What to expect

Survey teams will be present on public roads in Flynns Creek, Hiamdale, Willung, Stradbroke and Giffard West.

Some equipment, like traffic tube counters, will stay in place while the surveys are underway.

We won't be doing any surveys on private roads or entering private properties.

Why we're doing this

This traffic data will help inform the environmental studies for the project's Environment Effects Statement (EES), which looks at how the project might affect the local area.
