Introduction

The Victorian Government's 'Real Help, Right Now' Energy Affordability Assistance campaign promotes a range of energy bill assistance and support services available to Victorian households.

This includes the fifth round of the Victorian Government's **Power Saving Bonus** which provides a one-off \$100 payment to eligible concession card households from 25 August 2025. Eligible households can apply online at the Victorian Energy Compare website or get support to apply in-person or over-the-phone through our Community Outreach Program.

The **Victorian Energy Compare** website (<u>compare.energy.vic.gov.au</u>) is the Victorian Government's independent energy offer comparison tool. On average, people who used the website across 2024 saved \$240 by switching to the best priced energy offers.

People who may be having trouble paying their energy bills can also access our **Energy Assistance Program** – a free over-the-phone energy bill support service. It can help Victorian households to save money on energy bills through cheaper energy offers, energy concessions and grants.

Victorian households can save even more money on their energy bills by upgrading to energy-efficient appliances, with rebates and discounts available through Solar Victoria's **Solar Homes Program** and the **Victorian Energy Upgrades Program**.

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\$100 Power Saving Bonus – Key messages

Eligible households can access the \$100 Power Saving Bonus via the <u>Victorian Energy Compare website</u> or through our Community Outreach Program.

To be eligible, households will need to:

- Have a recent residential electricity bill
- Hold one of the following concession cards:
 - Health Care Card
 - Pensioner Concession Card
 - Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card
 - Veterans' Affairs Gold Card

One payment is available per household.
