Say Green Pty Ltd Support of Energy Mad Submission on Proposed Victorian Energy Efficiency Target Regulations 2018

Thank you for the opportunity for Say Green Pty Ltd] to submit feedback on the proposed Victorian Energy Efficiency Target Regulations 2018.

We have been registered with Essential Services as an A.P. since 16 August, 2011. During this time we have created over 6000 activities (over 25,000 globes) under Schedule 21b and over 10,500 activities under Schedule 21a.

We support Energy Mad's submission (Titled "Energy Mad Submission on Proposed Victorian Energy Efficiency Target Regulations 2018") on the proposed Victorian Energy Efficiency Target Regulations 2018.

In particular, we support Energy Mad's proposal that CFLs become eligible for replacement with LEDs in "Scenario 21A" of "Part 21 Activity – Incandescent lighting", and we support Energy Mad's proposed "GHG equivalent emission reduction variables" for Scenario 21A.

We believe the proposed amendments to Schedule 21A, combined with DELWP's "*fresh start*" initiative, would deliver significant volumes of cost effective VEECs.
